Four amazing LCC students return to tell their stories how TBI (traumatic brain injury), MS (multiple sclerosis), and the science of neurology have changed their lives forever.

Hayley Brown In June of 2012, while returning from charity work in Mexico, Hayley Brown was in a Cessna aircraft that crashed into the El Fuerte River. Hayley was treated in a hospital in Los Mochis, then transferred to the United States. In the accident Hayley suffered TBI among other serious injuries, a collapsed lung and brain swelling. She was placed in a medically induced coma. Her recovery has been an amazing

Breea Renee woke up on December 8, 2011 feeling "clumsy". By 6:30 she was in the emergency room with little feeling in her left arm and leg. By 9pm she was paralyzed on her left side, blind in her left eye, and losing her ability to talk and swallow. Tests revealed she has acute sudden onset of MS, or Clinically Isolated Syndrome.

Jon Fraser graduated last year after suffering a serious head injury just a few months before. Come hear how Jon came back so strong and is now dealing with his new realities.

Jeff Treiber graduated top of his class last year from San Diego State University with a major in psychology and a minor in cellular and molecular biology. While at SDSU, he studied brain development in children with autism using diffusion tensor imaging and fMRI and he has roughly nine publications. Last fall, Jeff began UCSD Medical School in preparation for a career in neurological surgery.
